As we continue to provide Friday updates to our community, please read the following reminders:

Social Media/Tik Tok Challenges

We want to inform you of new challenges on Tik Tok. These challenges ask students to do the various malicious activities and video record it and post it to Tik Tok.

- October: Smack a staff member's body part
- November: Kiss your friend's girlfriend at school
- December: Deck the halls and show your b**** (private parts/testicles)
- January: Jab a breast
- February: Mess up school signs
- March: Make a mess in the cafeteria or courtyard
- April: "Grab some eggz" (another stealing challenge)
- May: Ditch day
- June: Flip off in the front office
- July: Spray a neighbor's fence

Students and families should be aware that we have zero tolerance for this type of behavior. Students involved will be disciplined, assessed damages and fees for replacement of items, and we will prosecute through the appropriate law enforcement agency. If you hear or see anything, please notify your school immediately.

Flu Shot Clinic - Friday, Today October 1, 2021 from 2:30-6 in the Governing Board Room!

Mid-September to mid-October is the prime time to get your Flu shot. CCUSD and Albertsons/Safeway pharmacies are offering this to our community. The next event will be held on Friday, October 1 from 2:30-6:00 PM in the CCUSD Governing Board room - 33016 N. 60th St, Scottsdale, AZ 85266. Albertsons/Safeway will also have COVID-19 vaccination doses on site for anyone who is interested. You are able to receive your Flu and any COVID-19 vaccine at the same visit. If you are getting your second dose or booster, you must bring your vaccination card. This is a walk-in event, please bring proof of insurance for Flu shots, and all minors must be accompanied by an adult.

When students are sick

If your child is experiencing any symptoms of illness, keep them home. It is best practice to keep your children home when they are feeling any symptoms of an illness. Do not send your child to school if you are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.

Face Coverings

Face coverings are strongly encouraged for all students, staff and individuals, regardless of vaccination status while indoors and on school property to help prevent the spread at our schools. We urge families to consider this. Remember, that the distance for being identified as a close contact shrinks from 6 feet to 3 feet when students are wearing face coverings. This could reduce the number of students quarantined by the MCDPH and keep more students in school.
