

Dear CCUSD families,

Thank you for a great week of school. We want to take the time at the end of the week to share a few important reminders:

When students are sick

If your child is experiencing any symptoms of illness, keep them home. It is best practice to keep your children home when they are feeling any symptoms of an illness. Please do not send your child to school if you are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.

Face Coverings

Face coverings are strongly encouraged for all students, staff and individuals, regardless of vaccination status while indoors and on school property to help prevent the spread at our schools. In accordance with House Bill 2898, CCUSD cannot mandate mask wearing; however, we urge families to have those conversations.

Vaccinations

It is also highly recommended that those who are eligible carefully consider and are vaccinated against COVID-19. More than 60% of our staff and students are currently eligible for the vaccine. We will continue to make available opportunities for the vaccination, especially as the eligible age continues to lower, and we are in the process of planning another CCUSD clinic. Close Contact Quarantine

In the case that your child may have been exposed by close contact to someone who tested positive for COVID-19, the school will contact you via telephone and follow up with the new letter from the Maricopa County Department of Public Health. The new letter clearly defines the MCDPH quarantine guidance and MCDPH may follow up with you. Please be aware of the change below:

“Per the CDC, ADHS and MCDPH, close contacts are people who were within 6 feet of a person with COVID-19 while infectious for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period, regardless of whether masks were worn. [Exception: in the K-12 setting, a student who was within 3-6 feet of an infected student is not considered a close contact if both students were engaged in consistent and correct use of well-fitting masks at all times. This exception does not apply to teachers, staff or other adults in the classroom setting.] This exposure does not mean that your child has COVID-19 or will necessarily get COVID-19. Per MCDPH, and in accordance with CDC and ADHS guidance, close contacts who are not fully vaccinated or have not tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 90 days are to quarantine (stay) at home for up to 10 days. This includes being excluded from in-person school and extracurricular activities. Isolation and quarantine authority are delegated to MCDPH and outlined in Arizona Revised Statutes and Arizona Administrative code.”
