### **COVID-19 Adjustments**

The CCUSD Remain in School plan has been updated to include the following beginning Monday:

- Whole class elementary notifications to increase communication of positive cases
- Better align grade level recess practices
- Consistent seating chart practice on elementary busses
- Increased hand washing protocols and signage
- COVID testing site in cooperation with Embry Health
- 5th vaccination clinic hosting with Albertsons/Safeway pharmacies for Flu season as well as COVID-19

### **When students are sick**

If your child is experiencing any symptoms of illness, keep them home. It is best practice to keep your children home when they are feeling any symptoms of an illness. Do not send your child to school if you are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.

### **Face Coverings**

Face coverings are strongly encouraged for all students, staff and individuals, regardless of vaccination status while indoors and on school property to help prevent the spread at our schools. We urge families to consider this.

### **Vaccinations**

It is also highly recommended that those who are eligible carefully consider and are vaccinated against COVID-19. ### **Flu & COVID-19 Clinics**

CCUSD has again partnered with Albertsons/Safeway pharmacies to offer flu shots to our community. The event will be held on Friday, September 17 and October 1 from 2:30-6:00 PM in the CCUSD Governing Board room - 33016 N. 60th St, Scottsdale, AZ 85266. Albertsons/Safeway will also have COVID-19 vaccination doses on site for anyone who is interested. This is a walk-in event. Minors must be accompanied by an adult.

### **Free COVID testing**

CCUSD is proud to partner with Embry Health as they relocate their free COVID-19 testing site from the Holland Center parking lot to our unused CCUSD parking lot off of 56th Street, just north of the Desert Arroyo Campus. Their new site will open after the Labor Day weekend. This site will be appointment only and updates will be sent soon with how an appointment can be scheduled.
