### **Flu Clinics - The first event is today, September 17 from 2:30-6 in the governing board room!**

Mid-September to mid-October is the prime time to get your Flu shot. CCUSD and Albertsons/Safeway pharmacies are offering this to our community. The events will be held on Friday, September 17 and October 1 from 2:30-6:00 PM in the CCUSD Governing Board room - 33016 N. 60th St, Scottsdale, AZ 85266. Albertsons/Safeway will also have COVID-19 vaccination doses on site for anyone who is interested. You are able to receive your Flu and any COVID-19 vaccine at the same visit. If you are getting your second dose or booster, you must bring your vaccination card. This is a walk-in event, please bring proof of insurance for Flu shots, and minors must be accompanied by an adult.

### **When students are sick**

If your child is experiencing any symptoms of illness, keep them home. It is best practice to keep your children home when they are feeling any symptoms of an illness. Do not send your child to school if you are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.

### **Face Coverings**

Face coverings are strongly encouraged for all students, staff and individuals, regardless of vaccination status while indoors and on school property to help prevent the spread at our schools. We urge families to consider this. Remember, that the distance for being identified as a close contact shrinks from 6 feet to 3 feet when students are wearing face coverings. This could reduce the number of students quarantined by the MCDPH and keep more students in school.
